Be a Wild World Hero this Winter!




Welcome to the Winter Mini Challenge 2021!

Sounds great! How do I take part?



Each time you finish a book, add it to your personal profile page on this website. Add at least three books to your profile before the Mini Challenge ends to unlock your rewards.

Visit your profile page and tap 'Add a book to your profile' to log your books. You can rate each book out of 5 and write a review to let everyone know what you thought.
