Can you look outside of your window and draw a picture of your garden? Can you label the picture?

What do you have in your garden?  
Do you have grass, a patio, flowers?



Can you draw a picture of a flower in your garden or draw a picture of a flower you would like to have in your garden?

Can you name any spring flowers? Can you write the names of the flowers?



Can you design your own flower? How many petals will it have? What colour will it be?



\*Mine has 7 petals and its dark pink, light pink, orange, light green, light blue, light purple and dark purple.

Do you remember the story of 'The Hungry Caterpillar'? What did the caterpillar turn in to at the end of the story?



\*\*The caterpillar has eaten a lot of food and now forms a cocoon around himself and after some time he comes out of the cocoon and he has changed in to a butterfly.

## Big feet

Can you find the person in your home whose feet have grown the most?

Make a list of the people in your house.

Ask each person what size shoes they wear then write this number next to the person's name?

Have you found the biggest feet in your house?

You could try to order the shoes in your house from smallest shoe size to largest shoe size?



## Dress up like an adult

Ask a grown up if you could try on their grown-up clothes?

What kinds of clothes do they wear?

Have a go at putting their clothes on.

Look in the mirror to see how you look. Do the clothes fit you?

Do you look funny?

Does it look like you have more growing to do?

Why don't you do a fashion show and take photographs?
