Science experiment

By now you will know that plants need water to grow.

This experiment will help to show how water moves around the plant or flower.

Which part of the flower is helping to do this?

What if a plant was in soil? How would that plant get water?

Gather your equipment:



1. Pour about 3 cm of water into the glass.
2. Stir two teaspoons of red food colouring into the water.
3. Ask an adult to cut 1 cm from the end of the celery stick that has no leaves.
4. Stand the cut end of the celery in the red water.
