Words ending in ous

Some ous words, you can just add ous to these words to turn them from a noun into an adjective

Poison	poison <u>ous</u>
Danger	danger <u>ous</u>
Mountain	mountain <u>ous</u>
Courage	courage <u>ous</u>
Outrage	outrage <u>ous</u>
