

Nursery Activities

This weeks rhyme is 'If you're happy and you know it'. The challenges have been set around this nursery rhyme.

There are some activities to support your child. However you and your child can also create your own activities around the nursery rhyme.

6. Play 'I say, I do'

Say a random sentence from the song, e.g. the doors on the bus go open and shut and do the actions together. At first go slowly, saying different sentences and actions . Then say them faster and faster.

5. Role Play

Make a bus using chairs or cushions or whatever you want to use. One person will have to drive and you will need to stop to allow passengers on and make stops!



4. Count

Go for a walk around your local area. How many buses did you see?

You could count how many red cars you see?

Or think of your own counting challenge!
