

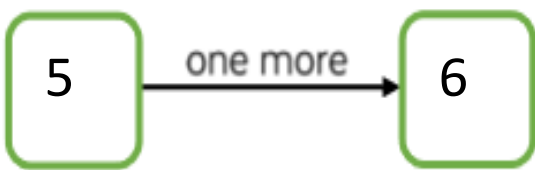

#### One more/One less



Make a set of number cards from 0-10. Choose one number and find what one more is and complete the box below. How many different ways can you complete the box below?

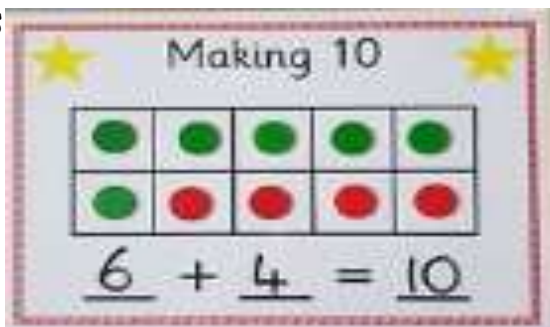
#### Representing Numbers 0-10

Ask an adult to show you a picture of a group of objects. You will then draw the amount, write the number digit and write the number word. Example below:

Picture	Draw it	Number	Write it
		3	three

#### Number bonds to 10

Using a ten frame (can be drawn or printed out) similar to the one shown below, can you find all the different ways to make 10. Use two different colours to help you see the number bonds



#### Shape Hopscotch

Ask an adult to help you draw and cut out some 2d shapes and place them on the floor. Ask your adult to call out a shape name and then you need to hop to the matching shape.



#### Match the number with the dots

Cut out 20 pieces of paper and on 10 of them draw dots from 0-10. On the remaining 10 write the numbers 0-10. Match the dots to the correct number.

Challenge: can you say the number of dots without counting each dot.



#### Which room in your house is the longest?

Measure all the rooms in your house using your feet. Find out how long each room is by counting how many foot steps you walk from one side of the room to the other.

Remember to put one foot behind the other.
