Can you tell your family what the weather will be like next week?

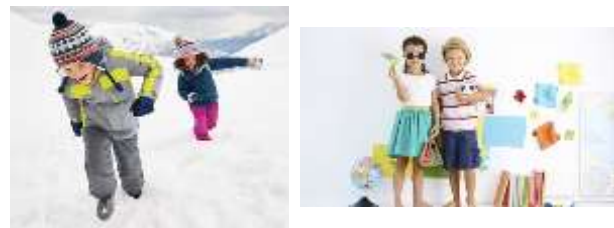


Dress up for the weather.
