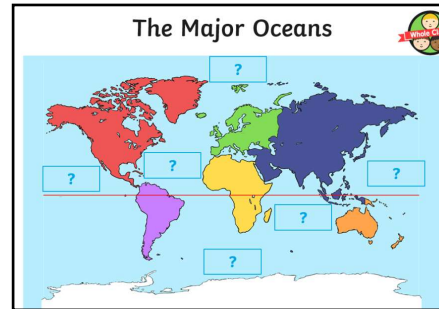

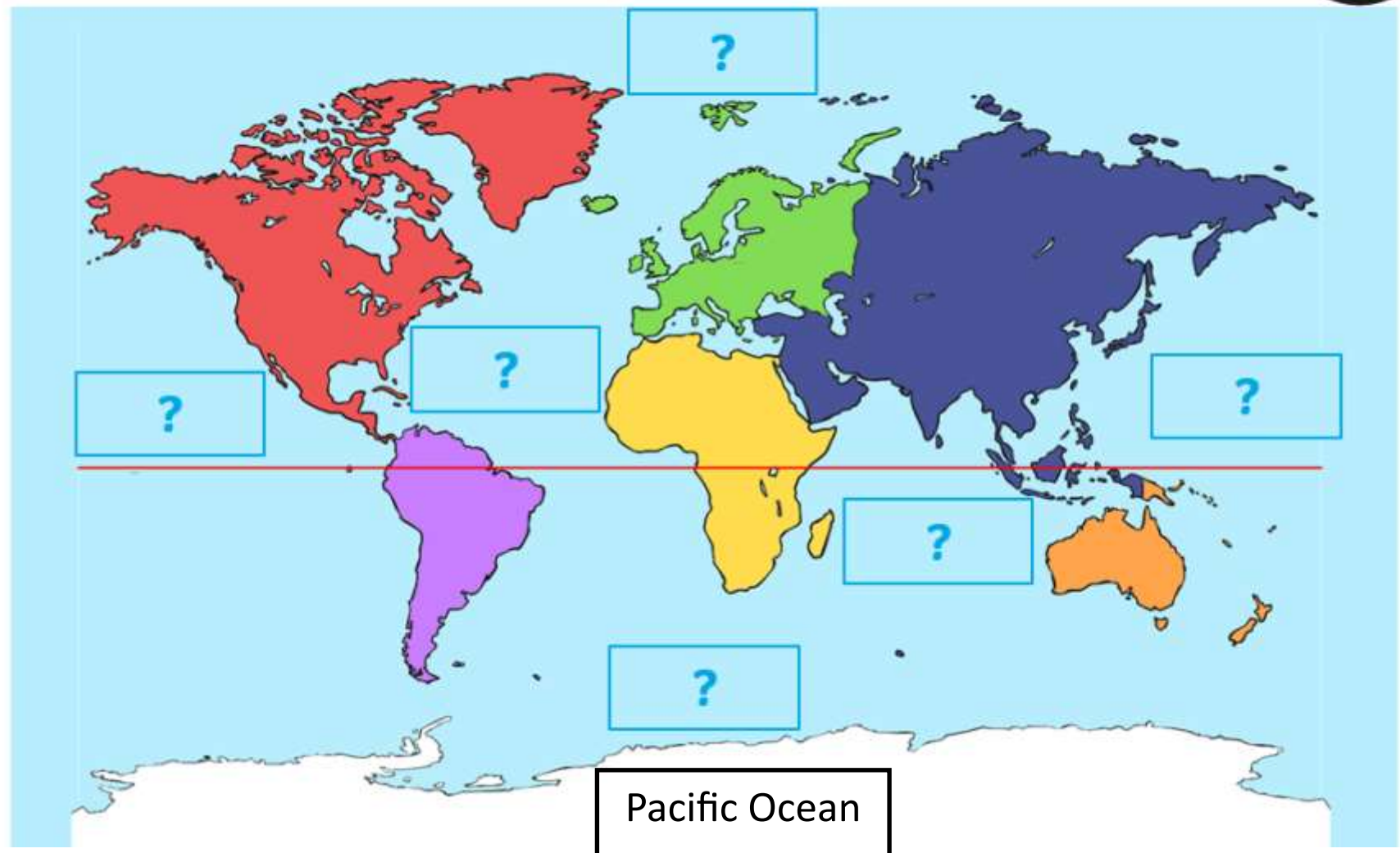


This week we are going to continue to look at the sounds in the 'ai' family. Click on page 3 to find your activity.
