Learn by heart of the week:
12 times tables and divisions

Choose 1 multiplication equation and write a division equation:

$$2 \times 12 = 24$$

$$24 \div 12 = 2$$

Now write a story to match each equation:

Yaser gave 2 friends 12 sweets each. How many sweets are there altogether?

Yaser had 24 sweets. He shared the sweets equally. How many sweets did each friend get?

Now repeat the above steps with another multiplication equation from the 12 times table.

12 times table

1 x 12 =	12
2 x 12 =	24
3 x 12 =	36
4 x 12 =	48
5 x 12 =	60
6 x 12 =	72
7 x 12 =	84
8 x 12 =	96
9 x 12 =	108
10 x 12 =	120
11 x 12 =	132
12 x 12 =	144
